**History:** The Stone Age

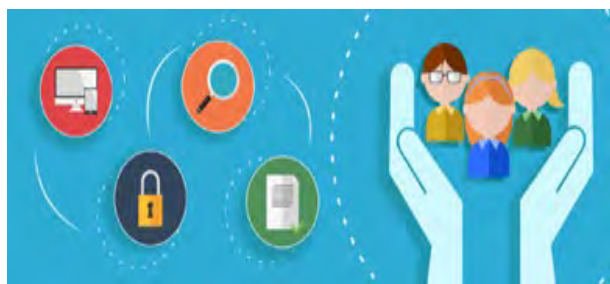
