The school day starts at 8.45am and ends at 3.15pm. Please make sure that your child has their reading book and book bag in school every day.

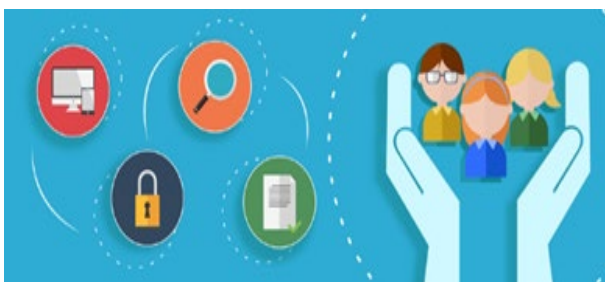
If you have any questions about any aspect of school life, please feel free to pop and see us at the end of the school day or contact the school office and we will get back to you as soon as possible.

Phonics

Children will continue their phonics journey following the Read Write Inc. phonics scheme. This is a systematic approach with two daily phonics lessons, which help pupils to become confident and fluent readers. Reading books are matched to your child's phonics level.

English

We will continue to use a range of high-quality texts to inspire and motivate the children on their reading and writing journey.

In writing we will continue to focus on forming each letter correctly and carefully and placing the letters correctly on the handwriting lines. We will develop writing simple sentences with finger spaces, capital letters and full stops. We will explore writing simple character descriptions, stories and letters.

Mathematics

Our maths topics will include exploring sorting objects into groups; recognising, naming and sorting 2D shapes; reading and writing numbers 1-20 in numerals and words; exploring simple addition and subtraction to 20; number bonds to 10 and reading and writing number sentences. We will continue to work on simple arithmetic skills, teaching children strategies on how to approach and solve simple arithmetic problems.

PSHE

Using the Jigsaw scheme we will explore the unit 'Dreams and Goals'.

Art

We will be learning all about ceramics and working with clay, learning how to mould and shape it to produce a clay tile

History

We will move onto our second topic looking at the History of Transport and how transport has changed throughout time.

Geography

We will be finding out about the Arctic and exploring what it is like to live there. We will find out where it is located; its weather and the animals and people which live there.

Science

We will continue to learn about seasonal change looking at what happens in the season of winter. Other topics will include Light and the Planets and the Solar System

RE - We will find out about Islam and what Muslims believe.

PE -We will be continuing our PE sessions with our PE Coach, Liam.

HOME LEARNING

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Regular reading at home is really important and will help your child become a confident and fluent reader. Children need to read home at least three times a week, but every day is better! Please write down in their reading diary every time they read at home, so we can award a dojo for each time they read at home. Alongside reading, homework is sent home each Friday and can be returned to school once it has been completed. In each class we have a homework box where completed homework can be put. Children who return their homework are awarded with dojos.

Year 1 Key Dates

*Monday - Reading Diaries Day

Reading diaries are handed in as children come into school so we can award dojos for super home reading.

*Monday - Borrow Books

Please return borrow books so your child can swap for a different one.

*Thursday - PE Day

Children need to come to school wearing their school PE kit.

PE kit - plain black bottoms (shorts/trousers with no labels or patterns), plain white t-shirt (no labels or patterns) and trainers.

Everyday -

*Reading book and book bag

Children need to bring both to school every day.

*Water bottle

Children need to bring a water bottle with their name on to school every day. Please do not send 'Stanley' type bottles as these are not sealed and cause lots of problems with spillages.
